
Please accept this letter as an addendum to our September 1st letter requesting an investigation into DC Councilmembers for using their Constituent Services Funds to make political contributions to DC Democratic organizations.

Upon reviewing the reports filed with your office for the reporting time frame from July 2, 2011 to October 1, 2011, it appears 3 DC Councilmembers used their Constituent Services Funds to make political contributions to DC Democratic organizations. Attached you will find the listing of these contributions. David Catania named his contribution as a "contribution" and Michael Brown named his contribution as a "donation" in their reports filed with your office. Additionally, it appears Michael Brown used his Constituent Service Fund to make a political contribution to "DC Federation of Democratic Women" which is not registered with your office.

As stated in DC municipal regulations section 3014.2 under sections (a) through (f), Councilmembers are prohibited from using their Constituent Services Funds to "promote" political parties. Political contributions were made by Constituent Service Funds to Democratic organizations. These contributions from the latest reporting period is in violation of DC municipal regulations.

The DC Republican Committee requests that the Office of Campaign Finance review these additional concerns. Please do not hesitate to contact our office at (202) 289-8005 if you have any questions. Thank you.
